



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Before writing an academic paper, it is important to read the chosen material more than just once.


The first reading acts on an emotional level.


Read first for enjoyment, without interruption

- 1. notice the use of language and word play
- 2. consider the actions of the characters:
- 3. note the setting and the atmosphere of the scene

Afterwards, as soon as possible, determine the impact

- 1. Do you have any unanswered questions?
- 2. Did you like the story?
- 3. Did you relate to any of the characters?






- 1. To answer any possible questions
- 2. To confirm what you already know

#### Determine:


- 1. elements which make the work successful
- 2. elements which could be changed/added to strengthen the work

# The third reading specifically targets a higher level of *critical* analysis.
