English 2333: Dual Credit

Purpose

Using a simple comparison exercise can help strengthen a more complex, analytical brainstorming process.

Guidelines

- 1. Recall the class discussions involving the Anglo-Saxon anonymous poem "The Wanderer."
- 2. After viewing a sort clip from the 1988 Wim Wenders film, *Wings of Desire*, discuss with your table partner the similarities and differences between the protagonist of the poem with the assigned focal character of the displayed scene.
- 3. Using an academic analytical process, state in five or more sentences how both figures have common/uncmmon traits and motivations despite the genre diffrences and the years between their individual creations.

Options for discussion:

- What thematic observation can you provide regarding these two characters?
- What symbols do they represent?
- What commentary are the unnamed poet and Wenders making about society?
