# *Presentation of Titles in MLA*

---

## ***Book titles are italicized.***

This includes epic poems, movies, plays, television programs, radio programs, and titles of paintings, sculptures, mixed media projects.

ex: Geoffrey Chaucer wrote the book, *Canterbury Tales*.

ex: *The Epic of Gilgamesh*, like *Beowulf*, are considered epic poems.

## ***Short stories, articles and essays, poems are all displayed within quotation marks.***

This includes one-act plays and television episodes.

ex: Geoffrey Chaucer wrote “The Wife of Bath’s Tale.”

ex: *Canterbury Tales* opens with a “General Prologue” which introduces all the major characters.

ex: Last night, a rerun of the 1960s television show *Twilight Zone* aired the controversial episode, “Nightmare as a Child.”
