

I-Frame Page

Following demo in class, construct a working I-Frame.

follow these steps for the project:

A. In Dreamweaver, create a basic page. *(inner text page)*

1. Create table: 1 row, 1 column, 275 pixels wide.
(You should use numerous rows containing additional information; do not limit yourself to this quantity of rows. HOWEVER ONLY USE 1 COLUMN.)
2. Border=0, Cell Spacing=0, Cell Padding=0
3. Modify page properties: top margin=0, left margin=0.
4. Paste 5 paragraphs of greeking from <http://www.lipsum.com/>.
5. Use a background gradient, designs, and images. Do NOT rely on a solid color background. Experiment with various background techniques.
Decorate this document as a typical page.
6. Save as text.html on desktop; browser title: autobiography of X.

B. Create new Dreamweaver document. *(outer "mat" page)*

1. Create table: 3 rows, 1 column, 700 pixels wide. Center in middle of page.
I.D. table as "main". Working with color scheme devised for text.html create elaborate texture, tiled image, or gradient background.
Be sure to modify page properties: top margin=0, left margin=0.
2. In the middle row insert a second table: 1 row, 2 columns, 100% wide.
I.D. table as "inner". Set content alignment from DEFAULT to TOP/LEFT.
3. In the left hand side column, insert image 500 pixels tall X 393 pixels wide.
Use this as a representation of your personality, a digital self portrait.
Be creative as possible. Be sure to use both `<alt>` tag and `<title=name>`.
4. In the right hand side column, insert a third table: 2 rows, 1 column, 100% wide.
Cell padding = "2", cell spacing= "2". I.D. table as "frame".
5. In the "frame" table, top row, create a text link back to your index.html page.
Be sure to modify page properties > links options. Do not leave these on default.
6. In the "frame" table SECOND row, click the cursor, then switch to CODE view;
make sure cursor is in correct spot, type the following:

<IFRAME SRC="text.html" height="475" width="300" frameborder="0" scrolling="yes">

```

7. Save to desktop. Title as "index.html"— create an appropriate browser title.

07. table-within-table-within-table strategy (three tables total)
08. text link returning viewer to index page
09. modify page properties
 - margins
 - text link options
10. update index.html with working links
11. maintain past web design requirements
 - all pictures have <alt="name"> tags AND <title="name">
 - all tables have identification
 - page design shows internal motion
 - no lost images
 - browser window is titled
