

# Exemplification *and* Process Pattern Writing

Below are a number of subjects which can be addressed with both a Process and an Example Writing Pattern.

1. Chose one subject as the focus of your paper.
2. Over the next few days gather preliminary research on your topic.  
Use the library database: *Academic Search Complete (EBSCO)*.
3. E-mail to instructor, or print out, one article on your subject to use as reference.
4. Brainstorm your opinion on the issues.
5. Begin drafting out an approach to your paper.
6. Keep your steps between 8 to 10 stages of development
