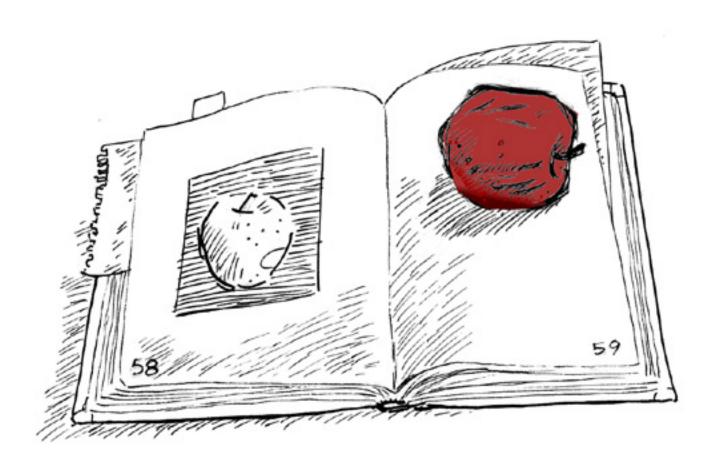
Virginia Woolf

- psychological experimentation
- creative manipulation of text, wording
- redefine perception of basic understanding of the reading process

Woolf uses her own sense of self within the story, acting as:

author > narrator > participating character > active reader of the text
