

Exemplification *or* Process Pattern

Below are a number of subjects which can be addressed with either a Process or an Example Writing Pattern.

- Chose one subject as the focus of your paper.
- Over the weekend gather preliminary research on your chosen topic.
- Print off an on-line article relating to your subject from database.
- Highlight any information you will use as evidence.

SUBJECTS

01. Should free speech on the internet be regulated and restricted? (Internet Censorship)
02. Is the United States' policies against terrorists effective? (War on Terror)
03. Do animal species deserve special rights? (Animal Rights/Animal Cruelty)
04. Should humankind invest in the exploration of space? (Space Exploration)

OBJECTIVES

1. Compose a full two page essay utilizing either pattern.
Use at least five sentences for each paragraph.
2. The subject should center around your choice from the supplied topics.
3. Be decisive in your subjective opinions.
 - Fictional devices and colloquial language are not permitted.
 - Back up your opinion with information found off school database.
4. Remember you must follow the standards for academic paragraph writing:
 - Open with strong topic sentences.
 - Write 3 or more supportive evidence sentences.
 - Conclude with a statement summarizing or strengthening your point.
 - Avoid fragments and run-on sentences.
5. Use strong transitions between paragraphs.
6. Be sure to follow the individual guidelines supplied over the past few classes.
7. For the paper title, state which pattern and which subject chosen.
Process: Global Warming
8. Despite the fact it is a persuasion piece, avoid excessive use of first person, singular.
