 - Use <u>at least</u> five sentences for each paragraph.
- 2. The subject should center around your choice from the supplied topics.
- 3. Be decisive in your <u>subjective</u> opinions.
 - Fictional devices and colloquial language <u>are not</u> permitted.
 - Back up your opinion with information found off school database.
- 4. Remember you must follow the standards for academic paragraph writing:
 - Open with strong topic sentences.
 - Write 3 or more supportive evidence sentences.
 - Conclude with a statement summarizing or strengthening your point.
 - Avoid fragments and run-on sentences.
- 5. Use strong transitions between paragraphs.
- 6. Be sure to follow the individual guidelines supplied over the past few classes.
- 7. For the paper title, state which pattern and which subject chosen.
